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**LEGAL GUIDANCE APPLICABLE TO INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS:**

Pursuant to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and in accordance with the law governing the protection of personal data in the Republic of Slovenia, students shall grant permission to the recipient (Slovenian Association for Lacanian Psychoanalysis) to process and manage the following personal data for the purpose of fulfilling their obligations to participate in an international study programme : 1. basic personal data (first and last name) [hereinafter: basic personal data]; 2. contact details (telephone number, e-mail [hereinafter: contact details]; 3. basic personal and contact details, photographs, and audio-video recordings for research, education and promotional purposes (public disclosure in various forms). To the extent necessary to achieve the individual purposes, the student shall give consent to the processing of basic personal data and contact details to the following data processors: 1. an accounting service company for the purpose of processing payments; 2. the administrator in charge of the computer system for data storage purposes. The student is aware that he/she may modify or withdraw this consent at any time by notifying the recipient's data protection officer (DPO) in writing and in person: Nina Krajnik (email: [nina.krajnik@sdzlp.si](mailto:nina.krajnik@sdzlp.si)), without this affecting the lawfulness of the data processing performed on the basis of the consent until its withdrawal. The student understands that under the GDPR he/she has the right to: 1. request access to his/her own personal data; 2. the right to request rectification, erasure or restriction of processing of personal data; 3. the right to object to processing of personal data; 4. the right to data portability; 5. the right to file a complaint with the Information Commissioner in the event of a personal data breach.
